The term and concept, Supply Chain Management, was introduced by a Booz Allen consultant during an interview over thirty years ago. It has evolved from a buzzword to a hard to understand concept to a proven roadmap offering organizations significant savings and revenue growth.

The dinner presentation on September 11 defines the Supply Chain Hierarchy of Evolution and discusses what organizations are doing to move through the various levels on their way to a "cradle-to-grave" or "cradle-to-cradle" fully integrated end-to-end network of organizations all focused on the ultimate customer.

Supply chain organizations are breaking down silos, causing collaboration, integrating sustainability, applying visibility, developing supply chain professionals, and managing their supply chains as the core of the business.
