



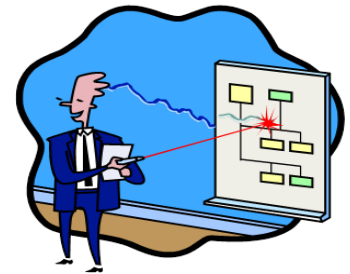

[E0816 Master Production Scheduler](#) - Analyzes inventory levels, historical usage, and sales projections to establish forecasts for future inventory requirements. The position will develop, maintain, and improve upon the organization's sales and operations planning process.

[E0815 Master Production Scheduler](#) - Analyze and set master production schedule for the facility. Provide planning support to new business development. Manage capacity analysis tools to allocate production's assets to meet customer attainment requirements.

[E0814 Buyer / Planner](#)- Responsible for the direction and coordination of daily production, planning and scheduling production in work centers; maintaining a dispatch list; quoting; placing orders; expediting raw material requirements; and controlling inventory levels

[E0813 Director of Quality Systems](#)- Responsible for the Quality Systems as they relate to Investigations, Training, and Auditing of Suppliers and CMOs.

[E0812 Somerset Packaging Manager](#)- Manage the filling and packaging operations of blisters, bottles, and cartons.

[E0811 Somerset Purchasing Manager](#)- Run purchasing and sourcing functions

[E0810 Sr Manager, Global Supply Chain Master Data Management](#)- Develop and implement a vision for the global Master Data management function with appropriate strategies that support the short and long term operational objectives of Technical Operations. Build and maintain strong relationships with global and regional supply chain planning groups, manufacturing sites, distribution centers and finance functions.

[E0799 Inventory Control Supervisor](#) - Responsible for managing a comprehensive inventory control strategy. Work closely with the financial team and the Inventory teams to develop and adjust the inventory control strategy to align with client and company requirements
