E0877 – Production Planner (Parsippany, NJ) – The Production Planner provides multi-site production planning support from all elements of Material Requirements Planning (MRP) Systems towards the chemical vapor deposition process of TM materials. The planner will assist with work-order scheduling while balancing manpower and equipment resources and provide input to productivity and quality improvement initiatives and looks for opportunities to reduce cost.

E0876 – Production Senior Planner (Parsippany, NJ) - The Sr. Planner will be responsible for the planning assigned product groups and will serve as a Lead/Mentor to Junior Planners and have approval responsibility for assigned Planner action plans. She contributes to the definition of the team’s objectives, and strategies, accepts team decisions and works toward their implementation and provides strategic input to and monitors the progress of cross-disciplinary project teams. The Sr planner proactively analyzes and interprets information for planning systems and determines if process are in control, accurate and meeting customer demands and effectively plans manufacturing recourses and diagnoses problems to minimize interruptions to production. As an integral part of the team, this person will work directly with Suppliers, Marketing, Accounting, Operations and Engineering to ensure excellent customer service levels while minimizing inventory investments.

E0875 - Materials Logistics Specialist (Trenton, NJ) – The specialist guides the monitoring of very complex materials through the production cycle. She develops and maintains reports; analyzes supplier capabilities to make/buy studies and cost analyses; and minimizes the total inventory costs. The specialist will also create production capacity plans; develop integrated project plans; implement short and long-range inventory and logistics strategies; and assess the impact and support changes to overall production schedules.

E0874 Export Operations Manager (East Rutherford, NJ) - The individual in this role will be responsible for the day to day export operations in NJ, and will manage a team of 8-10 direct reports. This position will also remotely oversee and serve as a resource for export operations at the MD and LA facilities. This key leadership position ensures the seamless functioning of the operations by efficiently managing our export systems in accordance with customs requirements. The Export Operations Manager will effectively troubleshoot and resolve issues that arise in international air freight transportation by applying sound judgment and a detailed knowledge of relevant U.S. and international regulations.
