SSW products can be found on most commercial aircraft flying today such as the Boeing 737, 747, 767, 777, 787 and the Airbus A320, A330, A350, A380.

Shukla Medical Xtract-All systems are used to remove orthopedic implants and current systems include hip joints, knee joints, IM nail, screw removal and spine.
